PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Private Residence

Ah, the ultimate California dream – a home in a beach community!

Your client is remodeling their new home, making it their dream home by the beach. The intimate home has 2 stories. The first includes an office and guest suite and access to the carport, laundry and wine storage. The second floor includes a master suite connected by a hallway to the living room, dining area and gourmet kitchen. The owners are in their early 50's and very active entertainers – eager to enjoy their new space.

Current finish and material types are indicated on the elevations, but any non specified information has been left to your discretion. Where materials are not indicated, finishes can be assumed as necessary. All assumptions must be justified in the narrative. Modification to the architecture is **not** allowed.

Your scope of work for the project is only the interior lighting and you will be required to comply with Title 24. This will be the 2005 Amended Standards since the 2008 Standards will not be in effect until July of 2009. The 2005 Standards can be found at:
